**RECTORS THOUGHTS**

We travel through the Christian seasons celebrating the life of Christ found in Jesus. With our focus on his life we search for his relationship with God. We search that we might also be filled with the spirit and know the experience of "Emmanuel", God with us.

The life of Jesus is in eight basic concepts about God's relationship with us and his universe.

1) Incarnation: Jesus is born into the world therefore God is in the world and cares for it.

2) Epiphany: The kings/wise men visit and pay homage to the defenceless child. Showing status and knowledge are of no value in the presence of God.

3) Baptism: Jesus comes to John for Baptism so that "we do all that God requires" according to St. Matthew. Jesus is showing humility.

4) Jesus teaches: The knowledge is passed on publicly.

5) Crucifixion: "Perfect love casts all fear". In accepting the cross Jesus overcomes the greatest fear - death, trusting in his perfect love in God.

6) Resurrection: In giving life freely Jesus triumphs over the illusions of this world.

7) Accession: The completion of Jesus' life on earth.

8) Pentecost: "Incarnation" God is in the world, in the life of individuals, in us. The life of Jesus shows us that the response to knowing God is Loving without conditions.

Here are 5 keys to knowing God. Each is a side of the other.

a) Breathing

Watch your breathing it will tell you when you are "resting" in God.

b) Non Judgement

"Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way as you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you". Mt 7:1-2

Don't set yourself up as God. Remember you only see partially.

c) Silence

Not only no talking but also refraining from commentating in your head. Just observe.

d) Taking responsibility

The story of Adam & Eve can be seen as a story about responsibility. Adam blames Eve, Eve blames the serpent, i.e.; each blames someone else for their actions.

e) Trust

Trust is another word for faith. You don't know all the details when you put your trust in another person or an idea/plan but you "know", your inner instinct tells you it will be OK.

## WILLOUGHBY WELCOMES

A condition of the Heritage Lottery grant for the community play in 2007 was that there should be a permanent display of the life of Captain John Smith. There are several displays already including a large one commissioned by ELDC, and the John Smith trail which includes boards displayed in St Helena's Church.

So as not to duplicate this, a display module is to be purchased. This will have a touch screen system, the same type that is used in museums and such like to give information. The presentation including video and text has been put together by Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School. This system has the potential to be used as a Tourist information point and information centre for the community, and is to be sited in St Helena's Church once the system has been manufactured and the necessary approvals obtained.

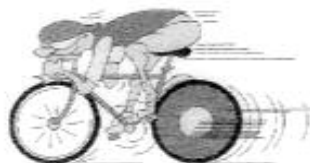

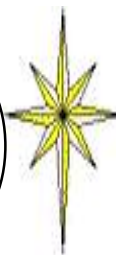
